The institute conducts Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTMs) to discuss students' academic progress, learning strategies, and overall development. These meetings focus on sharing observations, evaluation data, assessments, and assignments to track student improvement.

At Dr. Ulhas Patil Medical College and Hospital, under the Godavari Foundation, PTMs are held annually to ensure active parent participation. To accommodate as many parents as possible, the meetings are scheduled at convenient times and parents are informed in advance via SMS or phone calls.

A dedicated PTM committee is in place to organize these meetings twice a year, following academic reviews and assessments. Details of the meeting are communicated through various channels. Each session begins with an address by the Dean, highlighting the institute's vision, mission, and goals.

The PTMs provide a platform to discuss factors affecting learning, motivation, behavior, and interpersonal relationships. Students' planned performances are presented



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to parents for a clearer understanding of their academic standing.

Parents are encouraged to share feedback on their child's strengths, areas needing improvement, and suggestions for academic enhancement, fostering a collaborative approach to student success.
