All communities have intrinsic educational assets and resources that educators can use to enhance learning experience for students, especially for those medical graduates who want to pursue rural practice, Community-based learning refers to a wide variety of instructional methods and programs.


The interns, postgraduate students and senior faculties are posted in rural health centre at Bamnod. It is approximately 16 km from DUPMC Jalgaon. The centre caters to population of 14,000 (approximately). Daily average OPD patients are 30-40. The centre is managed by medical officer, nurses, pharmacist, lab technicians, health workers, sanitary inspector and other workers. DUPMC, Jalgaon posts interns and resident doctors of Medicine, OBGY and Paediatrics department to the centre. The interns are posted for a period 9 weeks in rotation. The resident doctors on rotation basis visit the centre on 2nd & 4th Thursday. This centre has out-patient department, in-patient department, laboratory, minor OT, pharmacy, vaccination room and labour room.

There is accommodation facility and food mess facility for interns.

Besides the posting in OPDs and OTs. The Department of Community Medicine carries out following activities at RHTC, Bamnod –

1. Seminar presentation- the interns give presentation on various topic
2. Health day celebration: various health days like world woman's day, world water day, world TB day, etc are celebrated and awareness programs are conducted.
3. Field visit-during field visits the students visit the nearby villages to learn about the common diseases, problems regarding environment and the nutritional habits of the villagers.
4. Various general and school health camps are organized in the periphery of rural and urban health centres.
